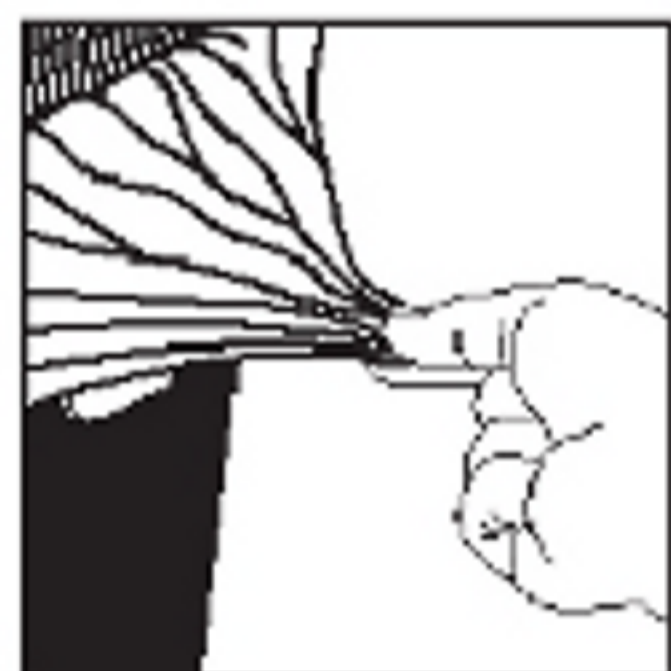


Applying the Cinch

For best results, make sure the surface you are applying the Cinch to is clean and dry. We recommend cleaning the area with isopropyl alcohol.



Important - New cans MUST also be cleaned to remove release agents from the manufacturing process.



Just "Pinch-It"



and



"Cinch it!"



WARNING: Do not put finger through opening.



Make sure the surface is clean and dry. Peel the backing off the tape and adhere the Cinch to the waste container as shown.

(Top of Cinch should be placed just under rim of the trash can)



The permanent adhesive can take up to 24 hours (recommended) after application to fully cure & bond. Using the Cinch sooner could result in a weaker bond.



Place the liner in the can, and then pinch the very edge of the liner (closest to the Cinch) and pull it out to form a "tail".



Poke the outer edge of the "tail" through the top of the Cinch. With your other hand pull the liner down from the bottom.

Pull more of the bag down through the Cinch until tight.
